



Request for Public Comments on the City of Johannesburg's Draft 2019/20 Integrated Development Plan, Medium Term Budget and Tariffs

In terms of Sections 16, 21 and 25 of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000, the Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003, the Municipal Budget Circular No 78, Municipal Entities Business Plan and the Municipal Property Rates Act 6 of 2004, the City of Johannesburg tabled its Draft 2019/20 Integrated Development Plan (IDP); Medium Term Budget (MTB) and Tariffs in the ordinary Council sitting on 14 March 2019.
