- NPO Registration certificate,
- Constitution also specifying target group and summary of Organizational activities,
- Proof of Address /Lease Agreement,
- Municipal Account statement,
- Organogram,
- Latest 3 months bank statement,
- Tax exemption certificate, Proof of PAYE Registration,
- Recent AGM Minutes and reports
- Recent Audited Financial Statements,
- Affiliation to professional or regulatory body (where applicable)
- Acknowledgement letter from ward councillor)
- Ensure all relevant documents as stipulated on the application form as well as your signature and signature of Commissioner of Oath, where required, have been included.
- NPOs should have been registered with the National Department for two years or more as at the closing date.
- A functional management committee or board members must be in place.
- A proper financial system should be in place, including administration and record keeping systems.
- Incomplete and late application forms will not be considered.
- NPOs without the necessary experience will not be considered.
- NPOs who do not have a valid tax clearance certificate from SARS will not be considered.
- NPOs previously or currently funded by the City of Johannesburg must attach their latest audited financial statements
