- NPOs should have been registered with the National Department of Social Development (NPO Directorate) for two years or more as at the closing date.
- A functional management committee or board members must be in place.
- A proper financial system should be in place, including administration and record keeping systems.
- Incomplete and late application forms will not be considered.
- NPOs without the necessary experience will not be considered.
- NPOs who do not have a valid tax clearance certificate from SARS reflecting Pin issue and expiry dates will not be considered.
- NPOs previously or currently funded by the City of Johannesburg must attach their latest audited financial statements
