

**REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON THE CITY OF JOHANNESBURG'S DRAFT 2024/25 INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT PLAN, DRAFT MEDIUM-TERM BUDGET, DRAFT RATES POLICY, DRAFT RATES BY-LAW, PROPOSED RATES TARIFFS AND PROPOSED TARIFFS FOR TRADING SERVICES AND OTHER SERVICES**

In terms of Sections 21 and 25 of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000, read with Chapter 4 of the Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003, the Municipal Budget Circulars No 98 and 99, Municipal Entities Business Plans and the Municipal Property Rates Act 6 of 2004, the City of Johannesburg considered and endorsed its draft 2024/25 Integrated Development Plan (IDP); draft Medium-Term Budget, draft Rates Policy; draft Rates By-laws, proposed Rates Tariffs and proposed tariffs for trading services and other services at the Ordinary Council meeting on the 19 March 2024 for public participation.
