1 OPENING

The Speaker requested the council to stand and observe a moment of silence. She stated that there was a building in the Johannesburg CBD that was on fire and people had lost their lives. She further stated that she started at the scene and some MMC's and leaders of political parties were at the scene.

She welcomed the Executive Mayor of the City of Johannesburg: Councillor K Gwamanda, the Whip of Council: Councillor N Zungu, Chair of Chairs: Councillor L Phillips, all political party leaders and whips, Members of the Mayoral Committee, Chairpersons of Section 79 Committees, fellow Councillors, City Manager: Mr F Brink, acting Secretary to Council: Mr A Gobinca, officials of the City of Johannesburg, residents of the City of Johannesburg, members of the media, ladies and gentlemen to the 14 Ordinary Council meeting of the City of Johannesburg Municipality.

She asked Council to stand and observe a moment of silence for the 64 lives that were lost when the fire broke out at the building in Johannesburg CBD, 49 people were hospitalised and 383 families were affected. She stated that some affected people were foreign nationals, and some were locals and the City Manager, MMC's and some officials were at the scene accessing the situation and still recovering some of the bodies.

She asked the Council to adjourn to allow the Executive Mayor, City Manager and the officials that are at the scene to focus on assisting with the tragedy. She said that the Council will resume at 11:30 and asked for the indulgence of all Councillors because lives had been lost and it was a great tragedy for the City of Johannesburg. She trusted that the good Lord would assist the affected families and assist the City of Johannesburg as they dealt with the tragedy.

She indicated that if further time was needed, it would be communicated through the whips of all political parties represented in Council.

At this point, time being 12:02, Council resumed, and the Speaker thanked Councillors for their indulgence. For allowing the executives to assist with the unprecedented tragedy that was faced by the City of Johannesburg.

She requested Legal to confirm quorum.

Councillor Rafferty (PA) requested for a 5-minute caucus break with all the whips and the Speaker acceded to the request.

After the caucus break, Councillor Rafferty conveyed the condolences to the families of the deceased. He said that the city was in crisis mode and the death toll was still rising. As a result, after the meeting with the whippers, they spoke to the executive and resolved that all the quarterly reports would be read into record and be noted.

With regards to the in-committee item, there was a request that an Extra – Ordinary Council meeting be convened to consider the report and the urgency reports be tabled and dealt with.

The Speaker gave whippery 5 more minutes for their caucus as it appeared that there was no consensus on what was reported on.

Councillor Arnolds (AIC) suggested that the executive consult with whippery so that they could get a clear understanding of what was agreed upon.

The Whip of Council requested 10 minutes with the whips of all political parties and the Speaker acceded to the request.

On resumption of Council, the Whip of Council conveyed the condolences to the affected families. He said that indeed it was a tragedy that no one could expect. He reported that the whippery had resolved that the meeting be adjourned and an Extra – Ordinary meeting be convened in the coming week as it would not make sense for Council to continue whilst 70 people had lost their lives.

The Speaker said that it was a prudent thing to do, and it was important to show leadership and compassion in this time and it was agreed that lunch would be donated to the victims and the Emergency Management Services (EMS) team that was on site.

The Speaker gave the Executive Mayor an opportunity to give feedback on the status of the tragedy.

The Executive Mayor extended his condolences to the families who lost loved ones in such a tragic manner. He registered with the House that the EMS was the first responder on the scene, and they did what they could under the circumstances to try and contain the situation. Their intergovernmental relations assisted quite a great deal as the MEC of Health, Ms Nomantu Nkomo-Ralehoko was able to allocate hospitals so that all the casualties could be transported there for immediate attention so that there were no delays.

He stated that the total number of fatalities was at 74 at that time, there were still forensics that were conducting investigations, going through the ashes that emanated as a result of the fire. He further said that it was indeed sad and appreciated the compassion of Councillors to agree that the meeting should be adjourned. He assumed that Councillors would begin to demonstrate humanitarian gestures like the Councillor who suggested that lunch be donated. He mentioned that as the City, they need to make a collaborative effort to not only respond to such issues, but to understand that the cause of that situation is historical in nature and for them to be able to find workable solutions to the current situation that requires a collective effort. Not just the external stakeholders but starting from the House in them demonstrating the unity across all political parties that are represented in Council.

He said that there were Ward Councillors who came from the area and who know victims by names, who are shuttered by what happened. He humbly pleaded with Councillors in the City of Johannesburg that this was a tragedy and not a platform for Councillors to play a blame game. He said that this was a moment for them to collaborate. As the executives, the resources would have to be marshalled towards

the relief that was required because there were 140 families that were displaced, and stock was allocated from JOSHCO to ensure that each and every one of them is accommodated during this tough time. JRA will be transporting the families from the building to the identified facilities.

He stated that the executive would issue out letters of a technical briefing as to what has happened so that Councillors would have a clear understanding and be able to assess and attain how they as Councillor can contribute towards a collective effort that is required. He said that they were open to everyone giving their input. He further said that the City of Johannesburg was responding to quite a number of disasters and did not know how many of them awaited the city in the future. He said that the inner-city needed their immediate attention and they needed to be compliant in their approach. He indicated that they needed all hands-on deck, and they would be going to hospitals where victims have been transported to. But as indicated, the executive would give Councillors in writing out of respect the first-hand information so that they can begin to engage the media so that they are able to appraise their constituencies with facts. He concluded that the city is their responsibility.

The Speaker added that of the deceased, 7 were children who had also lost their lives on this tragedy. She said that there were private entities and NGOs that were willing to assist. She asked Councillors that if they have any organisations in their capacities that could assist, they must approach her office as she is working closely with the Office of the Executive Mayor and the Office of the City Manager. She stated that the lighting of candles would be communicated to Councillors and Councillors who were available to join and pay their respect collectively as the leadership of the City of Johannesburg were welcome.

She reported that there was a Councillor from ActionSA who had a heart attack and was transported to Milpark Hospital in the morning and asked Councillors to keep him/her in their prayers.

The Speaker requested the Council to observe a final moment of silence before they adjourn.


