Highlights from the JDA's 22nd Year of Operations

Completion of Rea Vaya BRT Alexandra Bus Depot Access Road: The Rea Vaya BRT Alexandra Bus Depot Access Road, situated in Alexandra, Johannesburg, reached practical completion. This essential infrastructure will facilitate Phase 1C operations, enhancing connectivity and accessibility for commuters between Sandton, Alexandra, and Parktown.

Jabulani Safehub Swimming Pool: In Soweto, the completion of the swimming pool at the Jabulani Safehub marks a significant milestone in providing world-class recreational facilities for residents. The Olympic-sized community swimming pool, part of the Jabulani SAFA Safe-Hub, underscores the city's commitment to promoting aquatic excellence.

Commencement of Klipfontein Wellness Centre: Construction has commenced on the transformative Klipfontein Wellness Centre in Midrand, aimed at combatting drug and alcohol abuse. This state-of-the-art facility will include a clinic and a Social Development Drug Treatment Centre, reflecting our dedication to addressing social challenges and promoting holistic well-being.

Bold Step in Addressing Homelessness: The JDA has initiated the construction of a 200-bed displaced persons shelter in Devland, addressing homelessness and providing temporary accommodation and support to vulnerable individuals within Region G.
