City of Johannesburg to host Region A Revenue Open Day.

The City of Johannesburg will host Region A Revenue Open Day, to resolve all municipal account related queries on Saturday, 03 May 2025.

The City invites all Region A residents to attend a family-friendly regional Open Day. Region A comprises of suburbs like Midrand, Kyalami, Kya Sand, Dainfern, Glen Austin, Lone Hill Extensions, Ebony Park, Halfway Gardens Extensions and others.

The regional Open Days are part of the City's response to address and resolve municipal account related queries which have been raised by residents in each region.

Kgamanyane Maphologela, Group Finance's Director for Communications and Stakeholder Engagement says, on the day the City brings a host of services to the community including assisting residents struggling to pay their accounts, help the elderly to register for pensioner rebates and Expanded Social Package (ESP). Experts from billing, refunds, rates, valuations, legal, back office, front office, ESP, City Power, and Joburg Water will also be available to assist customers.

"The City encourages residents to bring their queries on the day. At the Open Day, they will have an opportunity to have face-to-face engagements with all officials specializing in municipal account services such as billing, water, electricity, rates, refuse, sewer, valuations and many more all under one roof," says Maphologela.

Maphologela says the City's Open Days allow the City to also give residents more information about the City's services.

"On the day, the City together with some of the entities, will set up stands, whereby information relating to the City's municipal services and programmes will be shared with residents," adds Maphologela.

Typical queries in Region A relate to water and electricity consumption, linking and de-linking of meters, sewer and refuse queries.

Maphologela encourages residents to be on the lookout for when the next Open Day will be coming to their areas.

“We appeal to residents to take full advantage of the Open Days to have their queries resolved,” says Maphologela.
