DEVELOPMENT OF AN E-HAILING MANAGEMENT POLICY FOR THE CITY OF JOHANNESBURG

The Johannesburg Development Agency (JDA), on behalf of the City of Johannesburg (CoJ) Transport Department, is currently developing an E-Hailing Management Policy for the City. This policy will guide the management of E-Hailing services as well as Scooter Delivery Services. It will focus on the following key nodes to inform the city-wide policy: **Sandton CBD, Rosebank CBD, Randburg CBD, Inner City Core, Soweto** (around Maponya Mall and Jabulani Mall), **Cresta Mall** and **Mall of the South**.

To ensure the project reflects the needs and experiences of all key stakeholders, three rounds of stakeholder engagement are planned with various stakeholder groups. E-Hailing Drivers and Driver Associations form a key stakeholder group in this process.
