### EXECUTIVE MAYOR COUNCILLOR DADA MORERO TO LEAD HIGH-IMPACT SERVICE DELIVERY OPERATION IN REGION A

The City of Johannesburg Executive Mayor, Councillor Dada Morero, is taking decisive action by leading a High-Impact Service Delivery Operation in Region A this Tuesday. This operation will focus on Wards 80, 92, 110, and 111. Under the theme "Re-imagining Joburg through the Eyes of the Residents," this initiative will tackle urgent service delivery challenges that have been exacerbated by vandalism, illegal water connections, compromised road and electricity infrastructure, sewer spillages, potholes, unlawful trading, illegal dumping, land invasions, and a range of other pressing social and economic issues impacting the communities of Ivory Park, Ebony Park, Kaalfontein, Rabie Ridge, and Commercials.

This comprehensive program will mobilise multiple City departments and entities, including Pikitup, Joburg Water, City Power, the Johannesburg Development Agency (JDA), Johannesburg Roads Agency (JRA), Johannesburg Metropolitan Police Department (JMPD), Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Environmental Health, Development Planning, and Social Development.

In addition, the Executive Mayor will conduct an oversight visit to the Presidential Park System, which is vital for supplying water in Region A. This visit will engage with the community Water Committee that has been established to work alongside the City in confronting water security challenges head-on.
