UNREGULATED INFORMAL TRADING COURT CASE BY SERI AGAINST THE CITY OF JOHANNESBURG

Executive Mayor of the City of Johannesburg, Councillor Dada Morero, will tomorrow attend court proceedings in a matter between the City of Johannesburg and the Socio-Economic Rights Institute of South Africa (SERI).

The City has raised concerns about unregulated trading activities that have contributed to escalating lawlessness, urban decay, and further strain on already compromised infrastructure in the Inner City. The City remains committed to upholding the rule of law while ensuring that the rights and dignity of all residents are protected. Central to this balance is the City's responsibility to enable inclusive economic participation while safeguarding public spaces, infrastructure, and the safety of communities.
