**City of Johannesburg’s Executive Mayor, Councillor Dada Morero, Unveils Completion of Phase One of Lilian Ngoyi Rehabilitation Project**

The City of Johannesburg announced the official unveiling of Phase One of the Lilian Ngoyi Rehabilitation Project, a landmark initiative dedicated to revitalising one of the city’s most historically and culturally significant streets.

This key project represents a major milestone in Johannesburg’s comprehensive urban renewal agenda, aimed at transforming public spaces to foster community pride, safety and economic vitality. The Lilian Ngoyi Rehabilitation Project has been a committed effort to enhance the area’s aesthetic appeal, improve safety standards and increase accessibility, ensuring it continues to serve as a vibrant hub for residents, businesses and visitors.

Expressing his excitement about this achievement, Councillor Dada Morero, Executive Mayor of Johannesburg, said: “The completion of Phase One of the Lilian Ngoyi Rehabilitation Project is more than an infrastructural milestone; it embodies our dedication to cultivating community pride, elevating living standards and advancing the socio-economic development of our city. Our goal is to create public spaces where everyone can thrive.”

The Mayor further explained that while the road has been officially unveiled today, the public will be able to access the rehabilitated street from 12 September 2025, as contractors complete the final touches for a smooth transition. The project has been delivered within the allocated budget, and momentum is now shifting to commence work on Phase Two.

The City of Johannesburg remains committed to executing projects that improve residents’ quality of life and to positioning the city as a dynamic, accessible and culturally vibrant urban centre.
