## **TRAFFIC ADVISORY:**

### **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF JACARANDA AVENUE & PRESIDENT FOCHE DRIVE INTERSECTION, OLIVEDALE**

Motorists are advised of an immediate temporary closure at the intersection of Jacaranda Avenue and President Fouché Drive in Olivedale due to urgent repairs of a water pipe burst. The western leg of Jacaranda Avenue at its intersection with President Fouché will be closed to all traffic in both directions (eastbound and westbound) effective immediately. This closure will remain in effect until repairs and road reinstatement works are fully completed.

#### **DETOUR ROUTES**

Road users are advised to make use of the following alternative routes:

- **Approaching from the East (wanting to proceed straight through the intersection):**  
Turn right at the Jacaranda Avenue intersection onto President Fouché Drive. Continue to Windsor Way, turn left. Turn right onto Blandford Road, and then turn left onto Bellairs Drive to re-route.
- **Approaching from the West:**  
Remain on Blandford Road. Turn right onto Windsor Way. Turn right onto President Fouché Drive, and finally turn left onto Jacaranda Avenue to continue your journey.
- **Approaching from the North (wanting to turn right at the intersection):**  
Remain on Windsor Way. Turn left onto Blandford Road and proceed towards Bellairs Drive to access surrounding areas.
- **Approaching from the South (wanting to turn left at the intersection):**  
Continue straight through the intersection. Turn left onto Windsor Way, and then use Blandford Road to access Bellairs Drive.

#### **MOTORIST GUIDELINES**

Road users are urged to exercise patience and caution when travelling through the area. Please adhere to the following:

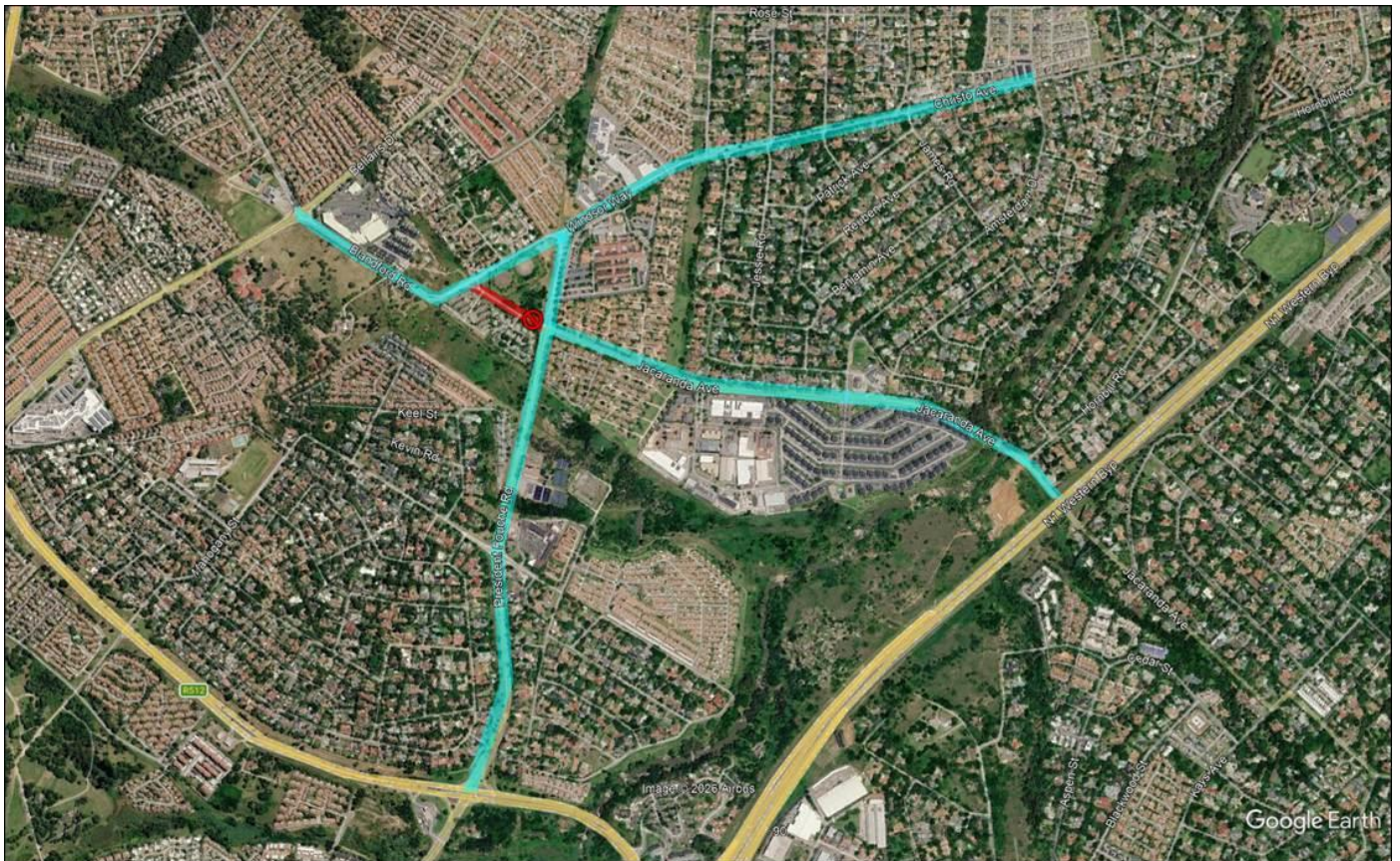
- Expect delays and, where possible, avoid the area altogether or plan your trip allowing for extra travel time.
