1. PURPOSE

The Group Communication and Marketing Department is initiating a procurement process in terms of Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations for the appointment of a service provider to assist with a live Multi-cam HD production and real time live-streaming

2. BACKGROUND

The primary role of Group Communication and Marketing is to manage the overall reputation of the City of Johannesburg locally and globally, which also includes promoting and strengthening the City of Johannesburg's brand and enhancing the City's digital footprint.

Group Communication and Marketing Department is continually seeking opportunities to positively influence perceptions about the City of Johannesburg (CoJ) and its leadership among its stakeholders, especially its online community.

Online platforms such as social media are increasingly being used to communicate the City's messages and raise awareness of its strategic direction, service delivery initiatives, programmes and projects. Social media advertising, or social media targeting, is effective in that it can provide huge increases in conversions and drive traffic in a cost-effective way.

To help the City of Johannesburg (CoJ) adapt, thrive, and improve in the digital environment, the department is undertaking a number of digital transformation projects such as livestreaming. This is also due to the COVID pandemic and physical events being limited. Live streaming enables the ability to communicate with a larger audience virtually. We can invite as many people as we would like to "attend" the event.

Sometimes people are interested in attending a particular event, but they can't attend in person due to work commitments or increasing expenses. Live streaming events and content live on the web makes it accessible to a worldwide audience. Livestreaming attendance can also surpass any capacity limitations a physical event would have.

Live streaming technology allows followers/people to watch, create and share videos in real time. All that is needed is an internet enabled device, like a smart phone, tablet or and a computer to watch.

3. OBJECTIVES

The objectives are the following:

- Reach a larger and bigger audience;
- Boost interaction between the City of Johannesburg and residents
- Attract and interact with new followers and create new relationships and opportunities with the City of Johannesburg
- Guaranteed reach using the City's content to elevate the brand - specific targeting and qualified leads;
- Strengthening engagement strategies for increased brand loyalty and a pull of satisfied residents

4. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES

The service provider will be required to provide a comprehensive written proposal as well as examples of similar work done, paying particular attention to the scope of work and deliverables.

The scope of work will entail the following:

1. Live- streaming of events to social media platforms using real time multi-camera (at least 2) HD production for 8 events (events may be at different locations within the 7 regions of Joburg);
2. Respond to queries specific to campaign being livestreamed;
3. Recording, packaging and sharing of livestream videos with COJ;
4. Compile a report detailing the performance of the livestreams for each destination platform

6. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Proposals will be evaluated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act of 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000), using the 80/20-preference points system of the Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2017.

The evaluation of bids shall be based firstly on FUNCTIONALITY (see 6.1 below). Only those bidders that score **65 points and more** on functionality shall proceed to be further evaluated in terms of price competitiveness. A bid that scores less than 65 points for functionality shall be regarded as **non-responsive** and shall not be considered for further evaluation.

Bids that meet the minimum requirements in respect of functionality shall be further evaluated on price and **Broad-based Black Economic Empowerment (BBBEE)** (see 6.2 below), in accordance with MFMA Circular No. 53, issued on 3 September 2010 by the National Treasury. The 80/20-preference points system shall apply wherein 80 points will be allocated for price and 20 points for BBBEE.
