

STOP VANDALISM

Vandalism is the action involving deliberate destruction of or **damage to public or private property**. This includes property damages, such as **graffiti** and defacement directed towards any property **without permission of the owner**.

Your **rates and taxes** pay for the infrastructure that makes this **City world class**. By not reporting **destruction and unauthorized removal** of public infrastructure it means you are prepared to pay to replace it.

The City of Joburg spends over **R60 million a year** to replace damaged and stolen infrastructure. This means as a rate payer you pay more than once for the same thing.

Public infrastructure makes the City functional and liveable, stop defacing traffic signs by pasting unauthorised notices.

How often do you come across vandalised municipal infrastructure and think to yourself **“this is not my business”** well as a rate payer it is your business as it is your taxes that pay for the initial infrastructure **setup and the replacement**.
